Recommendation of National Board Review	Action / Progress as of August 2015
<p>1. That the Dublin Province of the Redemptorists, through its Safeguarding Committee, develop comprehensive safeguarding guidance on the use of all types of information technology and electronic media.</p>	<p>The Safeguarding Committee has developed a comprehensive Policy and Procedures for Internet Use, Mobile and Electronic Communication (July 2015). This will now be considered by the Ordinary and Extraordinary Provincial Councils, with a view to approval and eventual inclusion in a revised Safeguarding Handbook.</p>
<p>2. That the Dublin Province of the Redemptorists, through its Safeguarding Committee, develop a Province-wide Training Strategy based on a thorough review of all of its training activities.</p>	<p>The Safeguarding Committee will now move to review all the training activities undertaken in both jurisdictions in Ireland, with a view to developing a Province-wide Training Strategy before the end of 2015.</p>
<p>3. That the Dublin Province of the Redemptorists, through its Safeguarding Committee, develop a standardised monitoring system that will allow it to generate an annual Child Safeguarding Monitoring Report for the Provincial and Council.</p>	<p>The Safeguarding Committee will also move now to develop a standardised monitoring system so that it can report annually to the Provincial and his Council, the first Report to be delivered in January 2016.</p>
